



The hotel itself is awarding a two night stay to one of the first 200 Prophets to book a room. You can see ANY Grand Line Officer to "donate" \$20 in exchange for an opportunity to be awarded all 7 nights at the hotel (parking not included), plus all the tickets an attendee usually purchases, except the golf outing, i.e., men's & ladies luncheon, Monday and Tuesday evening functions, Grand Monarch's Dinner and Red Tassel party.

This convention is for everyone, and it is a chance for all Prophets to come and be a part of the Grottoes of North America, not just the Grotto in your community. Grotto is about meeting new friends, and sharing Masonic fellowship with Masons from all over North America. It is about expanding your horizons and changing perspectives. See how Brothers from other parts of the Realm do things, and take some ideas back to your own Grotto and see if they might work for you. If you have never been to a Supreme Council convention, now is the time! Book your room, send in your registration, and come to New Orleans. It will be an experience you won't regret.

In closing, Jenny and I want to wish all of you a Merry Christmas and Happy Holidays. As we close out 2015 and move in to 2016, take time to reflect on the blessings we have been granted and the many wonderful adventures that lie ahead for each of us. Membership Programs

VIP PROGRAM

Any Prophet who sponsors a new member or reinstated member who has been out of the Grotto for at least 13 months between May 1st and April 30th will be entitled to attend the Grand Monarch's VIP lunch or breakfast at the Supreme Council Convention in New Orleans, Louisiana.

VIP(UNDER 40)

In addition to the VIP program, anyone sponsoring a new or qualified reinstated Prophet that is under 40 years old will receive a special (under 40) pin.

KEY PROPHETS

Any Prophet sponsoring 3 new or qualified reinstated members between May 1st and April 30th will be awarded a distinctive GOLD Key emblem. Any Prophet sponsoring 5 new members will receive a RUBY Key and for 7 or more new members a DIAMOND Key. A Prophet will receive one (1) key of the highest level he has earned. If in attendance at the Supreme Council Session, the key will be presented by the Grand Monarch.

The Supreme Council will reimburse a Grotto 50% of the cost up to \$300.00, for sponsoring a hospitality event at a Master Mason Event. This must be pre-approved, including a budget and is limited to one (1) per year. You must present your program for pre-approval with budget and can obtain forms from the Supreme Council Office or online at www. scgrotto.org under Secretary Forms. This cannot be used with other events.

LODGE VISITATIONS & REFRESHMENTS

We will reimburse a Grotto up to \$75.00 for attending and providing refreshments at a Blue Lodge Meeting. You must obtain pre-approval from the Supreme Council Office. These forms may also be found under the Secretary Forms online at www.scgrotto.org.

"ITS GREAT TO BE A GROTTO MEMBER"

Booklets are available at no charge from the Supreme Council office. A Grotto may have up to 100 per year. Sufficient quantities will be given to every candidate of a one-day class if allowed by the Grand Lodge of that Jurisdiction.



Prophet Retention

I have a question for you. What does a Prophet get for paying his dues at your Grotto? I know it is a provocative question. Yet, it is the question that gets to the heart of our trouble with demits and suspensions for non-payment of dues. It is in one aspect an economic issue. Do your members feel that they



are getting what they paid for? Is their dues payment a valuable and worthwhile expenditure of their financial resources? It is a question each and every Grotto must answer for itself.

Many have said that you cannot put a monetary value on Freemasonry. I would challenge that thought. I believe there are many brothers who do, in fact, put a monetary value on the Craft. They add an economic factor into their thought process around whether or not to participate in a certain group or activity. "How much does it cost?" and "Is it worth it?" are what they ask themselves. There is no denying it.

Our challenge is to respond to those questions by making the Grotto experience worth the expense of their money and their time. As we plan our years and our events we need to keep those thoughts in mind. "What are they getting for their time and money?" "If I were not a member, would this event make me consider joining?" "Can I describe a tangible value for the money spent to be involved?" Tough questions but each Grotto must answer them.

If we are going to retain our members we need to offer them something more than a boring or contentious business meeting. Neither is worth their time and money. We need to provide them with a meaningful, valuable experience. They are consumers of our product. What kind of product do we have?

I ask you to think about these questions as you plan for your 2016 schedule. You will not be able to change everything all at once. One thing at a time is an acceptable pace. What is not acceptable is doing exactly what you have always done. We all need to grow and improve. Make their Grotto experience worth their time and money and they will keep their membership.

NOTICE TO PROPHETS

Each year at the Supreme Council National Convention four (4) management positions are available. Three (3) of these positions the Grand Captain of the Guard, Grand Treasurer and a Grand Trustee are elected on the floor at the convention and are open to Past Monarchs and Monarchs only. The fourth position (Humanitarian Foundation Trustee) is appointed by the Board of Governors during the convention and is available to Past Monarchs and Monarchs.

1. GRAND CAPTAIN OF THE GUARD

The entry level position in the Grand Line. Duties are to guard the Supreme Council while in session and comply with all wishes of the Grand Monarch. This office should be completely familiar with the Supreme Council Code and be prepared to accept more responsibilities as he progresses through the Supreme Council Line to his ultimate goal of Grand Monarch. He is a voting member of the Supreme Council Board of Governors. He is paid mileage/per diem for attending the National Convention and actual expenses for Board Meetings.

2. GRAND TREASURER

Elected for one (1) year term. Duties and responsibilities are outlined in Chapter V, Section 5.6 of the Supreme Council Code. This officer is also a voting member of the Board of Governors as outlined in Chapter VI of the Supreme Council Code. He is paid mileage/per diem for attendance at the National Convention and actual expenses for attendance at other Board Meetings. Preferably, he should have a financial management background.

3. GRAND TRUSTEE

There will be one for three (3) year term this year. Duties and responsibilities involve the management of property and investing of Supreme Council funds as outlined in Chapter V, Section 5.11, 5.12 and 5.14 of the Supreme Council Code. He should be experienced in financial investing. He is paid mileage/per diem for attending the National Convention and actual expenses if ever to attend Board of Governors meetings.

4. HUMANITARIAN FOUNDATION TRUSTEE

This is a position appointed by the Supreme Council Board of Governors for a five (5) year term. For details of the duties and responsibilities of this position refer to Chapter X of the Supreme Council Code.
