NOTICE TO PROPHETS:

Each year at the Supreme Council National Convention three (3) management positions, the Grand Captain of the Guard, the Grand Treasurer and a Grand Trustee, are elected from the floor at the Business Session. These positions are open to Past Monarchs and Monarchs only. The fourth position, the Humanitarian Foundation Trustee, is appointed by the Board of Governors during their meeting and is available to Past Monarchs, Monarchs and Past Grand Monarchs. Below is a description of each Position's responsibilities:

- 1. Grand Captain of the Guard: The entry level position in the Grand Line. Duties are to guard the Supreme Council while in Session and comply with all wishes of the Grand Monarch. This office should be completely familiar with the Supreme Council Code and be prepared to accept more responsibilities as he progresses through the Supreme Council Line to his ultimate goal of Grand Monarch. He is a voting member of the Supreme Council Board of Governors. He is paid mileage and per diem for attending the National Convention and actual expenses for Board Meetings.
- Grand Treasurer: Elected for one (1) year term.
 Duties and responsibilities are outlined in Chapter V,
 Section 5.6 of the Supreme Council Code. This officer is also a voting member of the Board of Governors as

- outlined in Chapter VI of the Supreme Council Code. He is paid mileage/per diem for attendance at the National Convention and actual expenses for attendance at other Board Meetings. Preferably, he should have a financial management background.
- 3. Grand Trustee: This is for a three (3) year term. Duties and responsibilities involve the management of property and investing of Supreme Council funds as outlined in Chapter V, Section 5.11, 5.12 and 5.14 of the Supreme Council Code. He should be experienced in financial investing. He is paid mileage/per diem for attending the National Convention and actual expenses if ever to attend Board of Governors' meetings.
- 4. Humanitarian Foundation Trustee: This is a position appointed by the Supreme Council Board of Governors for a five (5) year term. For details of the duties and responsibilities of this position refer to Chapter X of the Supreme Council Code. Prophets interested in this position should submit a brief resume of their qualifications to the Supreme Council Board of Governors through the Supreme Council Office. Remuneration is the same as a Grand Trustee.



AAHMED Louisville, KY, Similarities found to AAMAD a ruler of Palestine and to ACHMET an Ottoman ruler 1703-1730

AAHMES Binghamton, NY, A King of Egypt, Sometimes referred to as AHMOSE.

ABACA Fredericksburg, VA, A Plant in the Philippines used in making rope. ABBAS E. Peoria, IL, Aramaic title is "Father" (ABBA) a port in the Persian Gulf. An uncle of Mohammad Shah Abbas 1 came to the Persian Throne in 1588 at age 16 and ruled for 41 years. "The Shadow" Abbas Bin Said about year 830 was famed mathematician.

ACACIA Oil City, PA, A small tree or shrub with white or yellow round flower clusters. Shrub has Masonic Significance. Some of the Ark Was constructed of this wood.

ACHBAR Columbus, OH, "Alla Achbar" is Arabic meaning "God is most Mighty." Achbar was a famous warrior and ruler. Ruled India in the Middle and late 1500. Born 1542 died 1605.

AL HASSAN Mobile, AL, The Oldest son of Ali Taleb. He became Caliph of Kufu. He was poisoned.

AL MATTA Dearborn, MI, Named after the Founding Monarch's wife. Alma Sandal.

ALEPPO Columbia, MO, A city in North Syria

ALETHEIA Worcester, MA, Aletheia translates as "Truth" in Greek.

ALHAMBRA Webster Grove, MO, The palace of Moorish Kings in Spain.

ALI BABA Warren, OH, The Woodcutter in "The Arabian Nights"

ALLA Dallas, TX, Name selected from middle letters in Dallas.

ALTAN KOL Tucson, AZ, Called "The Golden River" it runs to the lakes of Sing-Su-Hay and is said to have an abundance of gold in its sands. AMRITA Ft. Smith, AR, In Hindu Mythology the "Beverage of Immortality" also the largest of the Jambu or Rose Apple tree is the Amrita or Immortal One. Tibetan mythology applies the same word to a celestial tree bearing ambrosial fruit. AMROU Zanesville, OH, A Persian River. The Prince of Ormuz (ORMUS Grotto?) was raised in seclusion on the banks of the Amrou River by a quardian named MOHASSAN. ANKARA Shawnee, KS, Capital city of Turkey. Once called ANGORA.

Zindah Grotto in Waterbury, CT from its inception in 1833 to today has been a model of giving. It started when the Grotto was first chartered; they made arrangements for the Grotto Circus to come to Waterbury, Connecticut.

Zindah had the idea for a circus before any other organization in the area and membership grew to high numbers. This remained a membership driving force until concerns about insurance problems forced Zindah to abandon the circus and membership appeared to decline.

Zindah used the profits to help fund the Masonic Home in Wallingford, now called the Masonic Charity Foundation. Zindah also supported local charities in Waterbury and the surrounding areas. One of the prime charities was funding the cure for polio for which they donated 10,000 dimes per year till a cure was found.

Today, though small (28 members,) charity is still at the center of this Grotto with the members donating their time to do bell ringing for the United Way at Christmas time. They also support the Scottish Rite Center by donating their time and energy. Charity graced with Good Fellowship, a winning combination for all Grottoes.


