Membership Committee Tips & Reminders

The top line signer who brings in the most new initiates in a single month will receive a check for \$100. If there is a tie, that money will be split.

Master Mason events are when your Grotto hosts an event where the topic is Grotto and membership. If you want to host an event where you will be bringing in new members, send the required Pre-Event request form that can be found on the website under the Secretary Forms (yes, you will need the assistance of your Secretary on this!) After your event, send the final report, including the number of new initiates, along with the receipts and the SC will reimburse your Grotto half the cost, up to \$300.00. You may do this one time a year, provided you are also initiating 5 new members.

Your Grotto can also host a Blue Lodge event by providing refreshments for your Blue Lodge. Again, there are forms on the website for this. As above, you will be required to send a Pre-Event request form and follow-up with a final report with receipts to be reimbursed up to \$75.00 of the cost.

The key to both of these events is membership. Talk about it with the Masons you meet and offer them a pocket petition. If they accept, follow-up with them and include them in all things Grotto after they join.

You are the key to Grotto. Go ahead and open the door to the Enchanted Realm for others!





"As ye sow"

- 6. Have I told any of my friends of the aims and objects of the Mystic Order of Veiled Prophets with a view to getting their petition?
- 7. If I have been negligent, is it because I am at fault, or because the rest of the Prophets do not do their duty?
- 8. Am I going to continue in the same old way?
- 9. Am I a partnership with the rest of the Prophets in running the business of my Grotto?
- 10. Is it right for someone else to do all the work and then for me to expect an equal share of the benefits?

Grotto Name Meanings

Gul Reazee—Portland has a festival or roses each year. The Grotto took the Persian name Gul Reazee which translates "The scattering of Roses."

There is no reference found for Hapac.

Hassan—Sometimes spelled Hasan. An Arab Caliph from 624-669. The son of famous parents, ie: Fatima and Ali Ibn Abu Taleb.

Hejaz—A city in Mecca. Also spelled Hedjaz.

Ibn Saud—The "son" of Saud. A king or ruler of the city Hejaz.

Islam—The religious faith of Muslims. Allah as Deity and Mohammad as Prophet. In Arabic, "Submission to the will of God."

There is no reference found for Ka Jon.

Kaa Rheu Vahn—Phonetic spelling for caravan.

Kam Ram—Born in 1509. Was the second of three sons of Babur. Lived in his father's court at Kubul in the Hindoo Kush Mountains. Was a Lieutenant of his father.

Kedar Khan—He was the 2nd son of Ishmael. Name is also spelled Khedar Khan. Was King of Turguestan at the end of 11th Century. He usually traveled with 1400 horsemen with maces of silver and gold.

Daughters of Mokanna are celebrating their 100th Anniversary!

In 1889, in Hamilton, New York, a group of Masons, whose fundamentals of character are honesty, truth, justice, equality, and brotherly love, formed a new Order embracing the ideals of Happiness, Social Enjoyment, Understanding, Sympathy, and Good Fellowship. Thus the Grotto was born.



In 1919, several Prophets and their wives wished to form a woman's organization with the same principles. Grand Secretary Otto Hilderbrandt, Past Monarch of Rock Island, Illinois, along with Robert Rexdale, also of Amoo Grotto, and Carl Lundberg of Zal Grotto, Moline, Illinois, met with Josephine Mace, our Organizer, who became our first Supreme Mighty Chosen One. It was their support that allowed Mrs. Mace's dream to flourish and The Daughters of Mokanna was born on June 5, 1919.

The four original subordinate Daughters of Mokanna that opened in their respective communities were: #1 – Amoo - Rock Island, Illinois; #2 – Mohassan - Davenport, Iowa; #3 – Ankara - Kansas City, Missouri; and #4 – Zal - Moline, Illinois. Together, these four subordinate chapters formed the Supreme Daughters of Mokanna. Sadly, only Mohassan #2 is active today. Through the years, the Order spread to 20 additional states and into Canada.

Our beautiful ritual is entirely original and founded on an ancient Persian book entitled "The Story of Lalla Rookh." This Persian tale is our Ceremonial and is a lovely play that the Daughters enjoy. Many of the names of the subordinate Daughters of Mokanna are the names of persons, rivers, or places mentioned in the Story of Lalla Rookh. Most of the names of our officers were also found in this Persian book.

The aim of the Daughters of Mokanna is to bring into closer relationship the families of Grotto members and to promote Sociability, Friendship, Charity, Education and Patriotism. The purpose of the Order is to assist and cooperate with the local Grotto in every way possible. We endeavor to make our Ceremonials attractive and full of fun to help us to forget the worries of everyday life. Above all, we strive for cheerful good fellowship and to aid and comfort one another.

Our objectives are both social and philanthropic. Our major humanitarian work is supporting the Enchanted Lantern program through the Supreme Council M.O.V.P.E.R. Humanitarian Foundation. Additionally, we offer assistance to numerous local charities and organizations in our communities.

Although the Daughters of Mokanna were originally founded for female relatives of Grotto members, time and society has allowed us to seek members who are related to a Master Mason. Ladies who are currently members of other organizations recognized by the Masonic fraternity may also be eligible for membership.




