



Date: 1956

Taleb Grotto's Secretary Oscar F. Frisk

"I am pleased to pass along to you the requirements a Prophet must meet to be put in line of Office in Taleb Grotto.

Following are these requirements:

- 1. He must be officer material and Grotto minded.
- 2. He must be one who will work with the officers.
- 3. He must be one who will work with the other bodies.
- 4. He must be one whose daily work will allow him to put time and effort into the job.
- 5. He must be available during the week.
- 6. He must furnish a list of organizations in which he is interested together with his present or near future activity therein."

Nominations of the Committee are not final; any Prophet can be nominated from the floor, and elected, if sufficient votes are received.

We believe that, most important of all, is that he must be officer material. If he is not your organization will be weakened. Even though a Prophet is a good fellow, it's not sufficient to qualify him for the office of Monarch.

We hope that some of the weaker Grottoes will benefit by the above rules, and we believe they will if they adopt them and stick by them.

Grotto Name Meanings (Original Writings by Michael Wahl)

Monker: One of two terrible Persian Angels who are called "The Searchers of the Grave."

Moslem: Probably a variation on the spelling of Muslim.

Nazir: A title of respect. Nazar Fadladeen was Grand Chamberlain in the Harem that Lalla Rookh was in

No Ruz: Persian "New Years" Celebration which usually lasts 6 days.

Noruh: Started in Port Huron, Michigan. Huron spelled backwards.

Nubia: From the name of an ancient region and kingdom in Africa, south of Egypt. It possibly derives from the Egyptian word meaning "gold."

O Ton Ta La: A place where the Whang Ho River rises. A river of Tibet. At O Ton Ta La there are more than 100 springs. Hence the name O Ton Ta La means the "Sea of Stars."

Omala: The reverse of Alamo.

Oola Khan: A ruler. Fuzze Oola Khan signed an alliance with Ruler Hyder in 1760.

Orak: No specific reference found.

Ormazd: The supreme being in Zorostrianism. The Principle of good. The creator of the world.

Ormus: The Isle of Ormus, Marco Polo wrote: "It was sometimes so hot on the Isle of Ormus we lie in the water all day."




