



GRAND HISTORIAN'S CORNER



The more I dig into Grotto history, the more I learn. The artifact that I found for this article is from *Prophetable Ideas*, February, 1942. The article begins "With each Grotto now required to stage 2 ceremonials yearly..." So, 2 ceremonials yearly was not the way it has always been done. I am not sure what the previous requirement was, so if anyone knows, I would like to know.

The article continues with "Our attention was called recently that one of our splendid Grottoes faced an expense item of \$900 each time a full-form ceremonial was held." The article also explains that some Grottoes had expenses such as "rental of theatres and expenses incidental thereto." \$900 in 1942 is now worth \$15,124.

Then the article explains ways to cut the cost:

"A number of Grottoes possessed with the scenery and equipment, built for theatrical stages, solved the problem of building an extra inexpensive set composed of drapes, which are so arranged and built that a ceremonial can be staged in most any kind of room. Illusion of the scene is further

carried out by the addition of small painted sets representing rocks, bushes, tombstones and the like. Drapes are so arranged with hooks and eyes that they can be hung almost any place and then taken down and stored away in suit cases. Samis, for instance, is one Grotto that has two sets — the one composed of drapes that is generally used when the class of candidates is small, and the other regular set built for theatre use, and this generally used when the classes are large enough to pay the rental and other bills incidental to theatre use. This idea is worthy of consideration."

"Ormazd Grotto, at the Florida zone conference demonstrated what can be done along this line in a most splendid manner — equipment was 'entirely homemade' at a minimum of expense. They did a fine job both in staging and effects."

The artifact that this article was taken from also addresses Imp outfits, but I will save that for another day!




