

GRAND HISTORIAN'S CORNER

Past Perfection: Exploring the Enchanted Realm of Antique Grotto

Fraternal greetings Prophets and ladies. In writing this article I elected to feature a few of the antiques, collectibles and historic pieces I've assembled over my time in the fraternity. As Grand Historian I take pride in our rich history and I consider myself fortunate to be able to hold these items, learn their stories and origins and of course, share what I learn and find with the Realm.

Next, this fez was donated by Pro.
Marion Humphreys III, Grand Orator of Grottoes
International. A
Man-hat-tah Grotto fez. Man-hat-tah
Grotto M.O.V.P.E.R.
No.240 was instituted in December of 1944



in Manhattan, NYC, NY. Sadly, they surrendered their charter in 1973, making their antiques very rare.



First, a collection of three belt buckles created to celebrate the 100th year anniversary of the then Grottoes of North America, now Grottoes International in 1990. The gold is the most common with the bronze being the most rare.



Second is a pair of cufflinks from the early 1900s and is said to have belonged to Pro. Ernest L. Volganau, P.G.M. of Zuleika Grotto M.O.V.P.E.R. P.G.M. Volganau was Grand Monarch of Grottoes of North America, now Grottoes International, in 1914.

This is a photo of an undisclosed Grotto drill team from the 1933 Supreme Council Sessions of Grottoes of North America, now Grottoes International. This photo was taken on Michigan Avenue directly in front of the hotel on June 27th, 1933, in Chicago, Illinois, where the convention was being held. In 1933 Pro. Joseph B. Sieber, P.M. of Yusef-Khan Grotto M.O.V.P.E.R. was elected Grand Monarch.



Next, an antique Mokanna car grill emblem.



GRAND HISTORIAN'S CORNER



This fez is from Yusef-Khan Grotto M.O.V.P.E.R. No. 41 in Akron, Ohio, which was instituted on July 17th, 1911. Yusef-Khan Grotto is the home of our Most Potent Grand Monarch of Grottoes International, Pro. David Korb, G.M. and our current Right Potent

Grand Marshall Pro. Jeff Davis, P.M. Yusef-Khan Grotto has had two grand monarchs, the last being in 1959. They are Pro. Joseph Sieber, P.G.M. in 1933 and Pro. Clayton Herriott, P.G.M. in 1959.

This fez, in particular, is unique in that it belonged to a member of the Safety unit. At this Grotto, the Safety Unit was made up of law enforcement, firefighters, EMTs, and other first responders.

Next is a pin which belonged to Pro. Ray Prout. This pin was created to commemorate the 1929 Annual meeting of the Empire State Grotto Association being hosted in Poughkeepsie, NY.



S PPORT

This charm/pin is from the 100 year anniversary of the Enchanted Lantern. Won at auction at the 2024 Supreme Council Sessions. That evening I had the honor of presented the Humanitarian Foundation with a \$500 check from Ller Grotto M.O.V.P.E.R.



Lastly is a beautiful jewel from Keder Khan Grotto No. 12 in Syracuse, NY, one of the oldest Grottoes in the Realm being instituted in 1911. This jewel features 8 plates representing, each individually the year and location of the Supreme Council sessions from 1912 in Columbus, OH through 1930 in Kansas city, MO. The lower jewel features the Mokanna symbol and the upper jewel, a devil with pitchfork alluding to the original name of the Mystic Order of Veiled Prophets of the Enchanted Realm which is the Fairchild Deviltry Committee.

Historical artifacts relating to our fraternity tell the story of who we are and where we've been. Antiques remind us of the timeless beauty of the craft and its craftsmen. Our history is written, but our future is for us to write. Write what you love.


